



Kaltura Mediaspace

Download videos in an MP4 format

Kaltura Mediaspace defaults to downloading your videos in a WebM file format. If you prefer to download the video in an MP4 format, please follow the instructions below.

1. Log onto mediaspace.ccsu.edu
2. To navigate to your video, click on your **username** and from the menu select **My Media**. Click on the video you are interested in downloading (figure 1).

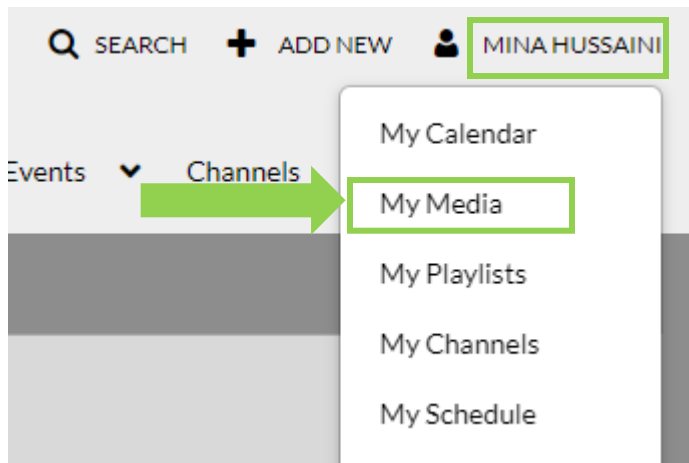

3. Click **Actions** and from the menu select **Edit** (figure 2).

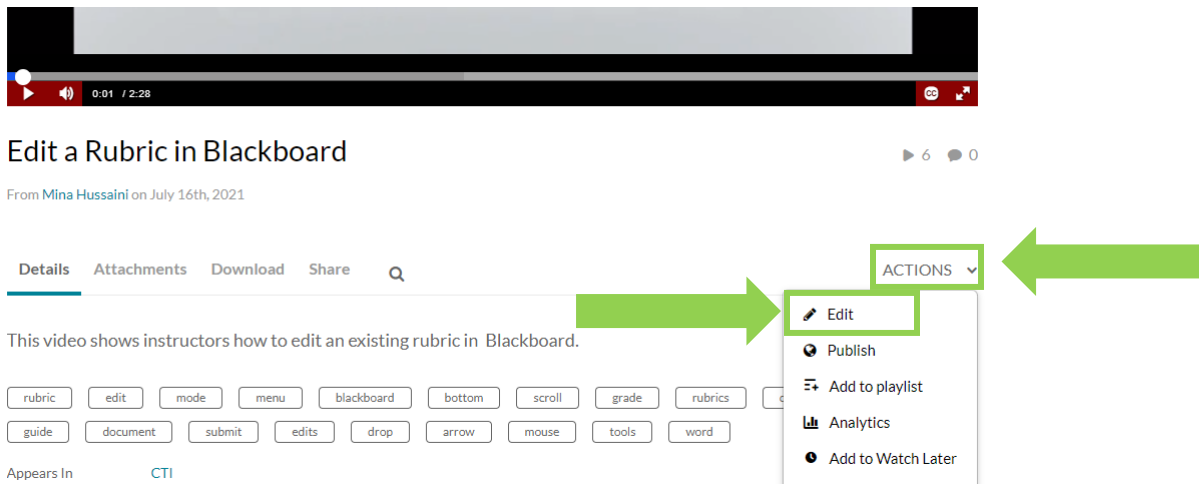

4. Click **Downloads** (figure 3).

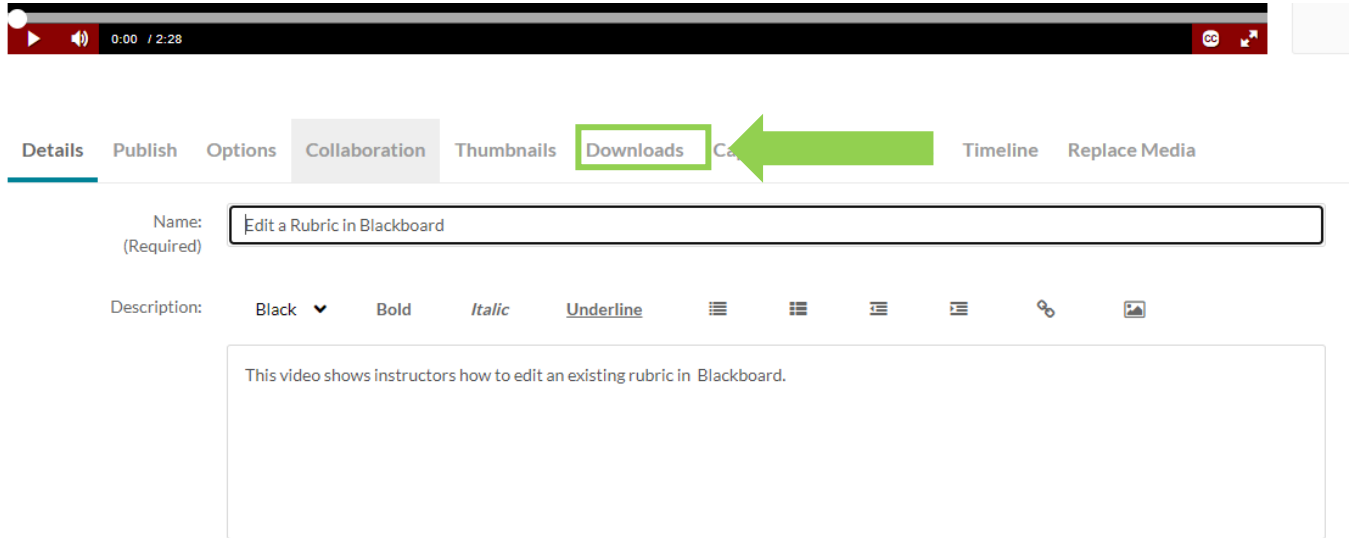

5. Check the box next to **Source** and click **Save**. It may take a minute or so to save. You will see a green banner at the bottom saying, “The information was saved successfully” (figure 4).

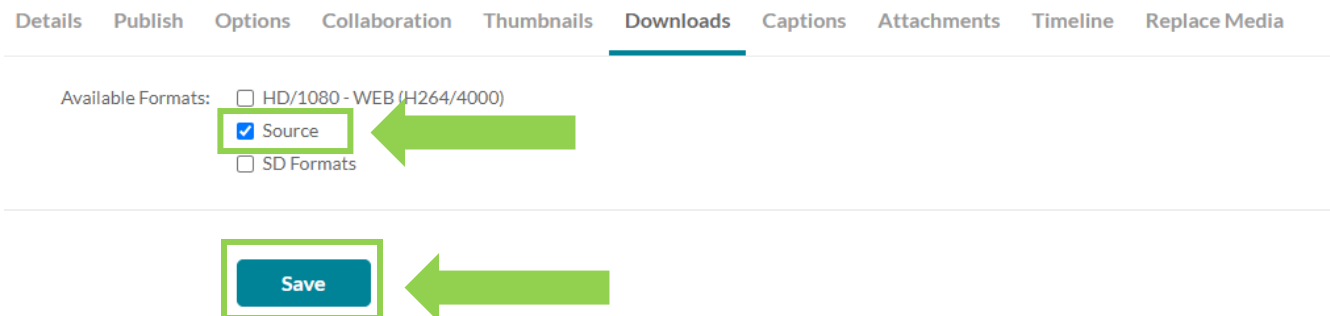

6. Return to your video and select **Download** (figure 5).
